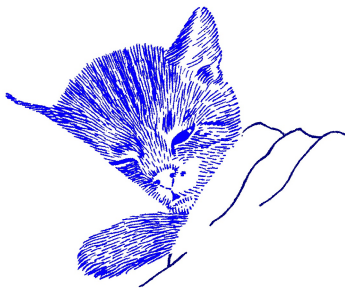

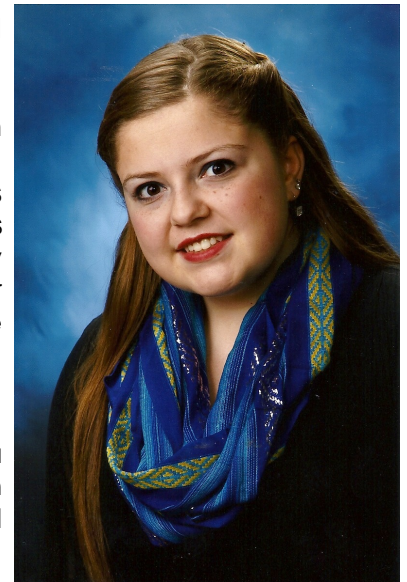

Annual Meeting Highlights

Members and officials participated in the credit union's 87th Annual Shareholders Meeting on May 19th at the Huntington Civic Arena. All those attending were given a welcoming gift bag, along with a copy of the credit union's 2014 Annual Report. During the proceedings, required business items were attended to, including the re-election of three directors to terms on the credit union's Board. Those re-elected to serve three-year terms were Chris Hutchison, Jerry Brown and Hargis Harris. Also, manager Chris Hutchison gave a state-of-the-credit-union address and offered details about the financial condition of our organization.

Additionally, the winner of the annual Pierce-Marcum Volunteer Scholarship Award was announced. Have you moved, changed your mailing address, e-mail address, or your cell phone number recently? Do you have a name change? If so, please let us know. It is important that the credit union has your current information on file. We want to make sure all communication and important notices from us reach you on time. It is extremely important to have valid phone numbers, especially cell numbers, in case our fraud prevention monitors need to contact you about debit or credit card usage.

If you have a name change, you will need to come by the credit union to update your signature card. For added security, change of address requests must be validated and made in writing. As a reminder, if you move out of the local area, you can continue your credit union membership. Our online account access makes it easy.
